Croeso! A warm welcome, we are looking forward to welcoming you and your child to our schools Nursery Class. We offer part time education once children turn 3 years old and then full time when they turn 4. We are here to support you and your child at the start of their learning journey.

In our Nursery class we strive to provide a hands on, play-based, fun and child initiated approach to education. We are a fully committed, approachable and caring team. The well-being of your child is our priority. We are a bilingual school- incidental Welsh language is firmly embedded within our class as well as our whole school. We are very fortunate to have a fantastic space as our classroom, inside and out, which is based around the children and their interests.

Here is some information about our class:

- Nursery opening times (please make every effort to be on time):

Morning session: 8.45-11.30am

Afternoon session: 12.30-3pm

- We have milk and fruit in school (in both sessions). Children can bring a piece of fruit, please label with their names, or you can buy fruit for 20p a day from our class fruit shop which is led by the children through the medium of Welsh.
- Your child will need a school bag with appropriate spare clothing. Please provide a spare change of underwear, socks, bottoms and a top. A warm hat is needed in winter and a sun hat and sun cream applied at home before school in summer. Warm, waterproof winter coats are an essential as we are out in all weathers as part of our curriculum.
- Labels/ names on all belongings are recommended.
- A spare pair of wellies to be left in school for winter months is recommended and also if they have an accident in school or their shoes get wet, it is always handy to have them to change into.
- Wipes and a plastic bag are handy for accidents.
- It is recommended that children are toilet trained so they are not missing out on key parts of their learning, we are here to help and support you and your child to make them independent toilet users. We do not provide nappies/pull ups or wipes in school.
- We have PE on a Monday and Friday- trainers on these days would be great.

We use the toilet in school because we are big grown-up children. We wash our hands after. I love singing the handwashing song.



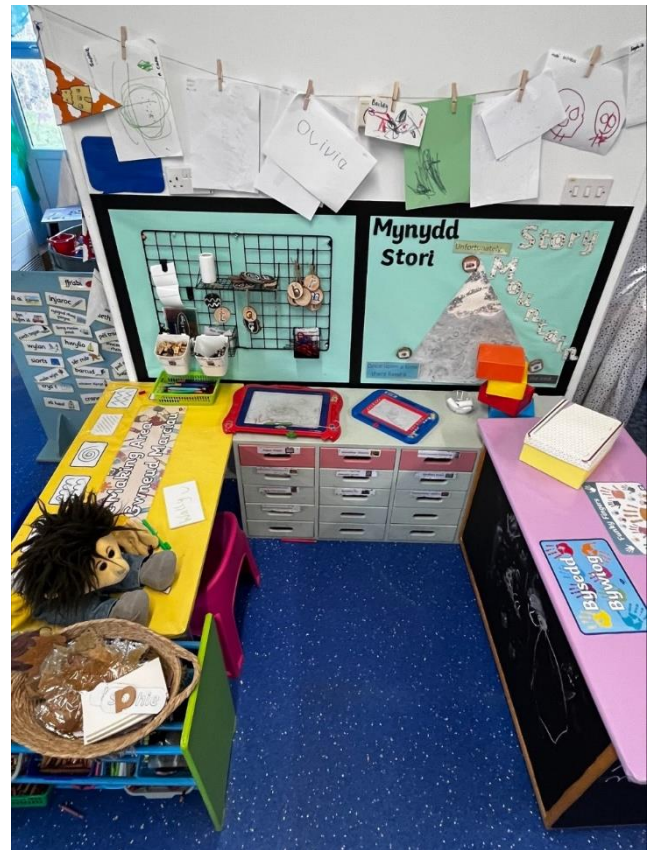
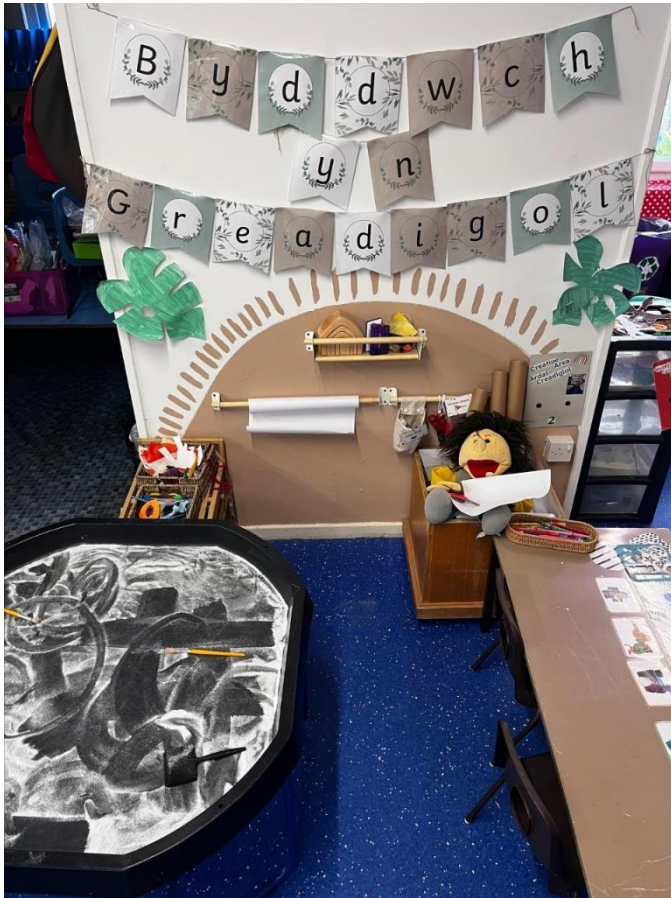


We have a snack of fruit and milk/ water in school. I love being the fruit shop keeper! We have all kinds of different fruit each week.

Learning Can Be Messy

Playing outside is so important. I run and jump and get lots of fresh air. Sometimes I might get grass or mud on my clothes.



Using a knife and fork at lunchtime is tricky! Sometimes I get food on my clothes!

I sometimes get pen and paint on my clothes! This is because I am developing creative skills and exploring lots of different ways of making amazing art!

Our mud kitchen is so much fun! I use all my senses, which is so important for my development. It also helps me use my imagination and practise playing with my friends nicely!



Exploring with playdough and other messy play resources like foam or food, helps me to develop fine motor control and build up muscles and coordination in my hands and fingers. I will need these when I learn to write.



Exploring in the water tray is giving me lots of maths and scientific skills! I love pouring, filling and emptying! I usually wear an apron but sometimes my clothes get wet!



When I get messy, I have been showing curiosity, determination, persistence, imagination and confidence!

In this class we learn and explore through play and experience. We experience messy play activities every day in school. We love spending lots of our curriculum time outside, we go outside every day in all weathers. We learn so much from splashing in muddy puddles, making mud pies and potions and playing with water outside. We help prepare food such as chopping strawberries. Best clothes are not recommended for our learning.
